Carnival fun for all ages at Cincinnati Art Museum's Art After Dark on June 30

CINCINNATI—Come one, come all to the *CAM Carnival*! Cincinnati Art Museum's FREE family-friendly event <u>Art After Dark: CAM Carnival</u> will include circus performances and games, live music from Well Seasoned, specialty cocktails (guests 21+) and food for purchase from <u>Quite Frankly Food Truck</u> and the museum's Terrace Café on **Friday**, **June 30**, **5–9** p.m.

CAM Carnival celebrates the largest display of American folk art in its history during its presentation of <u>A Shared Legacy: Folk Art in America.</u> The carnival atmosphere of the event highlights the artwork on view which includes a carousel bunny and elephant, carved eagles, furniture, portraits, paintings and much more. Access to the exhibition is FREE during the event.

In addition, quests will enjoy exclusive, after-hour access to the entire museum for free, including:

- 5–9 p.m.: Food available for purchase from Quite Frankly and Terrace Café.
- 5–9 p.m.: Free, after-hours access to special exhibitions.
- 5–9 p.m.: Guests may complete a survey for a chance to win a prize.
