CINCINNATI— The summer sun and the Black Rock Desert, home to the Burning Man event, serve as inspiration for the Cincinnati Art Museum's FREE evening event <u>Art After Dark: Life's a Beach</u>, Friday, July 26, 5–10 p.m.

Enjoy live music from Cincinnati-based reggae band The Cliftones, food for purchase from Eli's BBQ, Graeter's Ice Cream and Macaron Bar, docent-led tours and free admission to special exhibitions <u>No Spectators: The Art of Burning Man</u> and <u>Kimono:</u> <u>Refashioning Contemporary Style</u>.

Stunning immersive room-sized installations, mutant vehicles, creative costuming, films, jewelry and more transport the Cincinnati Art Museum audiences to the Burning Man gathering in special exhibition *No Spectators: The Art of Burning Man* (on view through September 2).

Kimono: Refashioning Contemporary Style (on view through September 15) celebrates the enduring influence of the kimono on

fashion. Inspired by materials, forms and decorative motifs since the opening of Japan in the mid-nineteenth century, western fashion designers, alongside other artists, have produced works that acknowledge and celebrate a Japanese influence.
