## **Art After Dark and Labor Day bookend last weekend to see “No Spectators: The Art of Burning Man”**



**CINCINNATI**— Celebrate the end of summer and take advantage of last-chance access to special exhibition *No Spectators: The Art of Burning Man* during the Cincinnati Art Museum’s FREE evening event [Art After Dark: All Good Things Must End](#), **Friday, August 30, 5–10 p.m.**

Additionally, for the first time since 1976, the Cincinnati Art Museum will stay open on **Monday, September 2, 11 a.m.–5 p.m.**, to bid farewell to the popular special exhibition.

During Art After Dark on Friday August 30, enjoy live music from Triiibe, 2018 Cincinnati Entertainment Awards Artist of the Year, food for purchase from Revolution Rotisserie & Bar, salads from Dewey’s Pizza, Graeter’s Ice Cream, docent-led tours and free admission to special exhibitions [No Spectators: The Art of Burning Man](#) and [Kimono: Refashioning Contemporary Style](#).

*No Spectators: The Art of Burning Man* offers stunning, sometimes participatory artworks that have emerged from the annual desert gathering in the summer by many of the artists and collectives associated with the event.

### **The timeline for *Art After Dark* includes:**

- **5–6 p.m.:** Happy hour on beer, wine and cocktails. (For guests 21+ only.)
- **5–10 p.m.:** Food available for purchase from Revolution Rotisserie & Bar, Dewey’s Pizza and Graeter’s Ice Cream (while supplies last).
- **5–10 p.m.:** Free admission to special exhibitions *Kimono: Refashioning Contemporary Style* and *No Spectators: The Art of Burning Man*.
- **6:30, 7:30 and 8:30 p.m.:** Docent-guided tours of the permanent collection. Meet in the Front Lobby. Free admission. RSVP not required.
- **5–9:30 p.m.:** Live music from Triiibe in the Alice Bimel Courtyard.

Art After Dark is free and open to the public. Parking is free. Though parking availability is not impacted by current construction at the museum’s front drive, ridesharing or utilizing public transit is encouraged.
